all, North Korea has about 50,000-60,000 workers abroad, mostly in Russia and China, with a mission to bring in foreign currency, according to the National Intelligence Service.

South Korean officials believe overseas North Korean restaurants have been suffering economically since stronger international sanctions were applied against North Korea over its nuclear test and long-range rocket launch earlier this year. The restaurant workers who defected to the South in April have said that their restaurant was struggling to meet demands from North Korean authorities at home for foreign currency, according to Seoul's Unification Ministry.

More than 29,000 North Koreans have fled to South Korea since the end of the 1950-1953 Korean War, according to South Korean government data. Many defectors have testified that they wanted to avoid the North's harsh political system and poverty.

She was speaking after opening a fourth overseas representative office for Rojava following similar moves in Moscow, Berlin and Stockholm. She said they aimed at giving the Syrian Kurds a voice overseas and promoting them as the best military force to defeat Islamic State (IS) militants in Syria.

"Our priority is to defeat terrorism and build stability in Syria," Mohamed said.

The French foreign ministry said it did not recognise the legitimacy of the Kurdish representative office. However, France is part of the US-led coalition that is carrying out air strikes in support of the PYD's military wing, the YPG, and groups fighting with it as they make advances towards IS' bastion of Raqqa.

"No one can leave. It's dangerous. There are snipers everywhere along the exit routes," one resident told Reuters by internet.  
About 100,000 civilians are estimated to be in Falluja which, in January 2014, became the first Iraqi city to be captured by IS, six months before the group declared its caliphate. The population was three times bigger before the war.  
The Iraqi military said it had dislodged the militants from Garma, a village to the east, overnight. No casualties were reported by the army or the city's main hospital. On Monday, eight civilians and three militants were killed, and 25 people wounded, 20 of them civilians, according to the hospital.  
The US-led coalition "is providing air power to support the Iraqi government forces in Falluja," its spokesman, US Army Col. Steve Warren, told Reuters by phone. — Reuters
